PURPOSE:

The Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) has awarded supplemental funding through the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (CARES Act) that requires programming in the 2019-2020 Annual Action Plan.

BACKGROUND:

The Substantial Amendment to the 2019-2020 Action Plan includes the following Community Development Block Grant Coronavirus (CDBG-CV) allocation and program funding awarded through the CARES Act:

CDBG-CV Funding for the City of Greensboro (\$1,329,635)

Proposed Uses of CDBG-CV Funds:

Eviction Prevention Pilot Program: \$100,000

Emergency Shelter Costs: \$266,000

Employment Training: \$100,000

Homelessness Prevention in the form of rental, mortgage, and utility assistance: \$863,635

BUDGET IMPACT:

\$1,329,635 in new federal CARES Act grant funds will be available to prevent, prepare for, and respond to the Coronavirus pandemic in Greensboro.
